The 12 That Changed the World #7 Andrew - People Need Jesus

John 1:44, Matt. 4:18-20, John 1:35-37, John 1:38-42

Principle: You have to meet Jesus; He <u>CHANGED</u> my life, and He can change yours.

3 Challenges from Andrew:

- 1. Wholeheartedly follow Jesus, but don't forget to BRING people with you. Matt. 28:18-20
- 2. Trust who God has created <u>YOU</u> to be and use it to lead others to Jesus. John 1:41
- 3. Remember that most people meet Jesus through the influence of an <u>INDIVIDUAL</u> person.

<u>3 Circles of Sharing JESUS:</u>

- 1. <u>God's Design</u> Gen. 1:31, Ps. 19:1, Rom. 3:23, Rom. 6:23a
- 2. Brokenness
- 3. <u>Gospel</u> Rom. 10:9

<u>Final Question</u>: Is there anything that would keep you from giving your <u>HEART</u> to Jesus right now?

John 1:44 Philip, like Andrew and Peter, was from the town of Bethsaida.

Matt. 4:18-20 As Jesus was walking beside the Sea of Galilee, he saw two brothers, Simon called Peter and his brother Andrew. They were casting a net into the lake, for they were fishermen. 19 "Come, follow me," Jesus said, "and I will send you out to fish for people." 20 At once they left their nets and followed him.

John 1:35-37 The next day John was there again with two of his disciples. 36 When he saw Jesus passing by, he said, "Look, the Lamb of God!" 37 When the two disciples heard him say this, they followed Jesus.

John 1:38-42 Turning around, Jesus saw them following and asked, "What do you want?" They said, "Rabbi" (which means "Teacher"), "where are you staying?" 39 "Come," he replied, "and you will see." So they went and saw where he was staying, and they spent that day with him. It was about four in the afternoon. 40 Andrew, Simon Peter's brother, was one of the two who heard what John had said and who had followed Jesus. 41 The first thing Andrew did was to find his brother Simon and tell him, "We have found the Messiah" that is, the Christ. 42 And he brought him to Jesus.

Matt. 28:18-20 Then Jesus came to them and said, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. 19 Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, 20 and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age."

John 1:41 The first thing Andrew did was to find his brother Simon and tell him, "We have found the Messiah" (that is, the Christ). 42 And he brought him to Jesus.

Gen. 1:31 God saw all that he had made, and it was very good.

Ps. 19:1 The heavens declare the glory of God; the skies proclaim the work of his hands.

Rom. 3:23 for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God

John 3:16 For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life.
