

- 300 Yet to Come with Jesus' Second Coming!











#### God can see all history – Past, Present, Future Simultaneously

-It was contaminated by sin, and humanity was separated from God, and unable to correct the situation. (2) God initiated a Plan of Redemption.










-It was contaminated by sin, and humanity was separated from God, and unable to correct the situation. -God initiates a plan to restore us to His original purpose & intention..

(3) Christ ushered in the New Covenant.

-Jesus' first coming partially fulfilled the OT prophecies, as He inaugurated the coming of the Kingdom of God.
-Jesus' second coming will completely fulfill the remaining prophecies.

(4) Christ transferred His message of redemption to the Church to take to the World.

Is given a spiritual gift to use in the body of Christ, so it's ministry is effective (1 Cor 12; Rom 12)


#### Each member of the body:


Is commissioned by Christ to participate in the evangelism of the world, making disciples to build the church (Matt 28:19-20)



(5) God will complete His Redemptive Plan through Christ's 2<sup>nd</sup> Coming. Properly seen, prophecy is just the culmination of the plan which God established before creation.



The Consummation is an already accomplished fact in the mind of God, a "float" that has already been created, but which has yet to "pass the grandstand." Why the confusion of interpreting prophecy?



# First, let's understand the rules of interpreting Prophetic Scripture

# #1 Make sure your "preunderstandings" line up with <u>Scripture</u>

# All interpreters have at least some theological and denominational prejudices.

## #2 Pay close attention to the Context

Every word in the Bible is part of a sentence.

Every sentence in the Bible is part of a paragraph.

Every paragraph in the Bible is part of a book.

Every *book* in the Bible is part of the whole of Scripture.

- Individual verses out of Context should not be used.
- "Scripture interprets Scripture."

### #3 Interpret in view of the Literary Form

- Historical books (Acts)
- Dramatic epics (Job)
- Poetry (Psalms)
- Wise sayings (Proverbs)
- Apocalyptic books (Daniel & Revelation)

### #4 Understand the historical and cultural background

- Jewish marriage rites

#### Daniel 8:9

"Out of one of them came another horn, which started small but grew in power to the south and to the east and toward the Beautiful Land."

- A Horned Animal used its horn as a weapon.
- The Horn became a symbol of power and might among the Jews.
- The antichrist started with "small horn" and it grew large, denoting that he emerges with localized dominion, and later attains global dominion.

### #5 Be mindful of the Law of Double Reference

### The Law of Double Reference

- A single passage of prophetic Scripture may refer to two events separated by a significant time period.
- Both prophesied events blend into <u>one</u> picture, masking the intervening time period.

#### Zechariah 9:9-10

Rejoice greatly, Daughter Zion! Shout, Daughter Jerusalem! See, your king comes to you, righteous and victorious, lowly and riding on a donkey, on a colt, the foal of a donkey.

#### Zechariah 9:9-10

10 I will take away the chariots from Ephraim and the warhorses from Jerusalem, and the battle bow will be broken. He will proclaim peace to the nations. His rule will extend from sea to sea and from the River[a] to the ends of the earth.

#### <u>Isaiah 7:14</u>

Therefore the Lord himself will give you a sign: The virgin will conceive and give birth to a son, and will call him Immanuel.

#### Isaiah 7:15-16

He will be eating curds and honey when he knows enough to reject the wrong and choose the right, 16 for before the boy knows enough to reject the wrong and choose the right, the land of the two kings you dread will be laid waste.


- Apparently, the verse had an immediate application to the King of Judah, and centuries later for the Messiah.
- Opinions concerning Isaiah's prophecy may differ because the prophet did not indicate and may not have realized that his prophecy had both an immediate & a future application.

 Not all of the examples of this kind of prophecy are as clear as Isaiah 7:14, since Matthew refers to it specifically.

 Some prophecies are "Near Application" and "Far Fulfillment."

#### "Foreshortening"

OT prophet or NT writer could not see that many years might separate two events (the valley between the mountain peaks)



The time of fulfillment of this prophecy hundreds of years in the future was unknown to the prophet.

# #6 Remember that Jesus is at the <u>Center</u> of all Prophecies

### #7 Always seek the Plain Sense

"Take every word at its primary, ordinary, usual, literal meaning, unless the facts of the immediate context... indicate clearly otherwise." -David Cooper

"Unless the text indicates clearly that it should be taken symbolically, the passage should be understood literally." -Arnold Fruchtenbaum #8 Determine if it is to be translated Literally or as an Allegory.

#### Augustine (400AD)

- Literal 2<sup>nd</sup> Coming of Christ
- Literal Heaven and Hell
- Millennial 1000 year reign- allegorical The church is already living in the millennium as part of the spiritual kingdom of God, with Christ reigning in the hearts of Christians.

#### Augustine (400AD)

- Augustine's <u>allegorical</u> view became the dominant view of the Roman Catholic Church.
- Also, key reformists like Martin Luther and John Calvin adopted his view.
- Continues to impact theologians and denominations today.

Will the millennial kingdom involve a literal thousand-year reign of Jesus on earth, or does it refer to Christ's present spiritual reign from heaven over the church?

Do the covenant promises made to Israel in Old Testament times (the Abrahamic and Davidic covenants) relate to Israel, or are they spiritually fulfilled in some way in the church?

The judgment seat of Christ for Christians, the judgment of the nations following Christ's return, and the great white throne judgment of the wicked dead following the millennium?

Are they separate and distinct judgments, as literalism holds? Or do they describe one general judgment at the end of the age, as the allegorical school holds?

Jesus' consistent literal interpretation of Old Testament Scripture- including prophetic OT Scripture – is one of the most convincing pieces of evidence for a literal approach to Scripture.

### How We can avoid Prophetic Imbalances

### 1. Avoid Prophetic Agnosticism

A prophetic agnostic is a person who says, "I am unsure about Bible prophecy." Such a person has doubts about whether Bible prophecy is accurate or trustworthy.

## 2. Avoid Prophetic Sensationalism

Prophetic sensationalism consists of using exciting or shocking stories or language about prophecy at the expense of accuracy to provoke public interest or excitement in prophecy.

### 3. Avoid Newspaper Exegesis

Newspaper exegesis involves having a newspaper in one hand and the Bible in the other, forcing headlines from the newspaper into the text of prophetic Scripture.

### 4. Avoid Setting <u>Dates</u> for Prophetic Events

Let's live our lives as if the Lord could come for us today but plan our lives as if we'll be here our entire life expectancy. That way, we are prepared for time and eternity.

### 5. Avoid Division with Other Christians

#### We hold to the Facts...

- Christ will return for His own.
- No one knows when Christ will return, only God.
- He will judge the World.
- There will be a time of great trouble on the earth at the end of the ages.
- The final conflict will be won by Christ.

#### We hold to the Facts...

- Satan, his angels, and those who are without Christ will be cast into the Lake of Fire forever.
- Jesus will take his children to live on the New Earth with Him forever.
