



# No Question that Jesus is Returning

## The Question...

Will there be two phases to Jesus' 2<sup>nd</sup> Coming?

- First, to Remove His Church from this World ("The Rapture"), then
- Later to Reign ("The Glorious Appearing").

Or

Will Jesus return once to Earth to judge and reign?

"After that, we who are still alive and are left will be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air. And so we will be with the Lord forever." -1 Thess 4:17 "Caught Up" = "Harpazo" (Greek) "Caught Up"

### 1 Thess 4:13-17

Brothers and sisters, we do not want you to be uninformed about those who sleep in death, so that you do not grieve like the rest of mankind, who have no hope. For we believe that Jesus died and rose again, and so we believe that God will bring with Jesus those who have fallen asleep in him.

### 1 Thess 4:13-17

According to the Lord's word, we tell you that we who are still alive, who are left until the coming of the Lord, will certainly not precede those who have fallen asleep. For the Lord himself will come down from heaven, with a loud command, with the voice of the archangel and with the trumpet call of God, and the dead in Christ will rise first.

"After that, we who are still alive and are left will be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air. And so we will be with the Lord forever." -1 Thess 4:17 Mark 13:33-37 Be on guard! Be alert! You do not know when that time will come. It's like a man going away: He leaves his house and puts his servants in charge, each with their assigned task, and tells the one at the door to keep watch.

"Therefore keep watch because you do not know when the owner of the house will come back—whether in the evening, or at midnight, or when the rooster crows, or at dawn. If he comes suddenly, do not let him find you sleeping. What I say to you, I say to everyone: 'Watch!'"

### 1 Cor 15:50-58

I declare to you, brothers and sisters, that flesh and blood cannot inherit the kingdom of God, nor does the perishable inherit the imperishable. Listen, I tell you a mystery: We will not all sleep, but we will all be changed in a flash, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trumpet.






The sting of death is sin, and the power of sin is the law. But thanks be to God! He gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.





# The Glorious Appearing

"When the Son of Man comes in his glory, and all the angels with him, he will sit on his glorious throne. All the nations will be gathered before him, and he will separate the people one from another as a shepherd separates the sheep from the goats." -Matt 25:31-32

## Rev 19:15-19

Coming out of his mouth is a sharp sword with which to strike down the nations. "He will rule them with an iron scepter." He treads the winepress of the fury of the wrath of God Almighty. On his robe and on his thigh he has this name written:

King of kings and Lord of lords.

And I saw an angel standing in the sun, who cried in a loud voice to all the birds flying in midair, "Come, gather together for the great supper of God, so that you may eat the flesh of kings, generals, and the mighty, of horses and their riders, and the flesh of all people, free and slave, great and small."

19 Then I saw the beast and the kings of the earth and their armies gathered together to wage war against the rider on the horse and his army.

-Rev 19:15-19

On that day his feet will stand on the Mount of Olives, east of Jerusalem, and the Mount of Olives will be split in two from east to west, forming a great valley, with half of the mountain moving north and half moving south.

The Lord will be king over the whole earth. On that day there will be one Lord, and his name the only name. -Zech 14:4,9

# "At that time people will see the Son of Man coming in clouds with great power and glory." - Mark 13:26

"Then will appear the sign of the Son of Man in heaven. And then all the peoples of the earth will mourn when they see the Son of Man coming on the clouds of heaven, with power and great glory" - Matthew 24:30

The day before Jesus went to the Cross, He prepared His disciples to function during His absence (the church age) and addressed them with the first detailed reference to the rapture.

# John 14:1-3

"Do not let your hearts be troubled. You believe in God; believe also in me. My Father's house has many rooms; if that were not so, would I have told you that I am going there to prepare a place for you?

# John 14:1-3

"And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come back and take you to be with me that you also may be where I am."

# "The End of the Age"

- The Disciples used the terms: "The sign of your coming" and "the end of the age."
- When Jesus comes physically to this earth, it will be to end this period of time and usher in a whole new age an Age when He will be the King of kings and will rule the earth.

# The Chronology of the Rapture

- 1. The Lord Himself will descend from His Father's house, where He is preparing a place for us (Jn 14:1-3; 1Thess 4:16).
- 2. He will come again to receive us to Himself (Jn 14:1-3).
- 3. He will resurrect those who have fallen asleep in Him (deceased believers whom we will not precede—1Thess 4:14-15).
- 4. The Lord will shout as He descends ("loud command," 1 Thess 4:16). All this takes place in the "twinkling of an eye" (1 Cor 15:52).

- 5. We will hear the voice of the archangel (1 Thess 4:16).
- 6. We will also hear the trumpet call of God (1 Thess 4:16).
- 7. The dead in Christ will rise first (the corruptible ashes of their dead bodies are made incorruptible and joined together with their spirits, which Jesus brings with Him—1 Thessalonians 4:16-17).
- 8. Then we who are alive and remain will be changed (or made incorruptible by having our bodies made immortal—1 Corinthians 15:51,53).

- 9. We will be caught up (raptured) together (1)
  Thessalonians 4:17).
- 10. We will be caught up in the clouds (where dead and living believers will have a monumental reunion—1 Thess 4:17).
- 11. We will meet the Lord in the air (1 Thess 4:17).
- 12. Christ will receive us to Himself and take us to the Father's house "that where I am, there you may be also" (Jn 14:3).
- 13. "And thus we shall always be with the Lord" (1 Thess 4:17).

14. At the call of Christ for believers, He will judge all things. Christians will stand before the judgment seat of Christ (Rom 14:10; 2 Cor 5:10), described in detail in 1 Cor 3:11-15. This judgment prepares Christians for...

15. The marriage of the Lamb. Before Christ returns to earth in power and great glory, He will meet His bride, the church, and the marriage supper will take place. In the meantime, after the church is raptured, the world will suffer unprecedented outpourings of God's wrath during the time our Lord called "the great tribulation" (Matthew 24:21).

## Rapture/Blessed Hope

- 1. Christ comes in the air for His own
- 2. Rapture of all Christians
- 3. Christians taken to the Father's house
- 4. No judgment on earth
- 5. Church taken to heaven
- 6. Imminent—could happen any moment
- 7. No signs
- 8. For believers only
- Time of joy
- 10. Before the "day of wrath" (Tribulation)
- 11. No mention of Satan
- 12. The judgment seat of Christ
- 13. Marriage of the Lamb
- 14. Only His own see Him
- 15. Tribulation begins

## Glorious Appearing

- 1. Christ comes with His own to earth
- 2. No one raptured
- 3. Resurrected saints do not see Father's house
- 4. Christ judges inhabitants of earth
- 5. Christ sets up His kingdom on earth
- 6. Cannot occur for at least seven years
- 7. Many signs for Christ's physical coming
- 8. Affects all humanity
- Time of mourning
- 10. Immediately after Tribulation (Matthew 24)
- 11. Satan bound in abyss for 1,000 years
- 12. No time or place for judgment seat
- 13. His bride descends with Him
- 14. Every eye will see Him
- 15. 1,000-year kingdom of Christ begins

# The "Tribulation"

Anyone who takes the Bible literally must accept the fact that it teaches there is a time of *tribulation* awaiting the inhabitants of this earth.

- The OT prophets had much to say about this time period.
- Revelation has 13 chapters to describe it in detail.

# There is more Scripture related to the Tribulation than:

- The 1,000-year reign (Millennium)
- Heaven or Hell
- Any subject except Salvation & the 2<sup>nd</sup> Coming

"There will be great distress, unequaled from the beginning of the world until now"

-Jesus Matt 24:21

The main point of controversy about the Tribulation is whether the church will go through this period of distress or will be raptured before it begins.

# Daniel 9

Called by Tour Traine

### The 70 Weeks of Years

20 While I was speaking, praying, confessing my sin and the sin of my people Israel, and presenting my petition before Yahweh my God concerning the holy mountain of my God-<sup>21</sup> while I was praying, Gabriel, the man I had seen in the first vision, came to me in my extreme weariness, about the time of the evening offering. 22 He gave me this explanation: "Daniel, I've come now to give you understanding. <sup>23</sup> At the beginning of your petitions an answer went out, and I have come to give it, for you are treasured by God. So consider the message and understand the vision:

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Seventy weeks<sup>b</sup> are decreed about your people and your holy city—to bring the rebellion to an end, to put a stop to sin,

### **New International Version**

# The passage shows 3 Periods of Time

When Jerusalem would be rebuilt (7 Heptads=49 years)

"Know and understand this: From the time the word goes out to restore and rebuild Jerusalem until the Anointed One, the ruler, comes, there will be seven 'sevens,' and sixty-two 'sevens.' It will be rebuilt with streets and a trench, but in times of trouble. -Daniel 9:25


# The passage shows 3 Periods of Time

After the sixty-two 'sevens,' the Anointed One will be put to death and will have nothing.

# The passage shows 3 Periods of Time

- When Jerusalem would be rebuilt
- When Jesus would be crucified
- A Time of Tribulation

The people of the ruler who will come will destroy the city and the sanctuary. The end will come like a flood: War will continue until the end, and desolations have been decreed. He will confirm a covenant with many for one 'seven.'

-Daniel 9:26b-27

In the middle of the 'seven' he will put an end to sacrifice and offering. And at the temple he will set up an abomination that causes desolation, until the end that is decreed is poured out on him."

-Daniel 9:26b-27





## Timeline of the Tribulation in Revelation:


- Rev 6-7: First 1/4
