Luke 13:10-17

Finding yourself in a hopeless life. Luke 13:10-11, 14-17

- Bent **over** by life. Luke 13:10-11, 16; Mark 5:1-43; Ps. 38:6-10; Luke 5:31-32; Matt. 9:35-37; Luke 4:18-23
- Bound by **Satan**. Luke 13:11, 16; John 12:31, 14:30, 16:11; Job 2:6; Matt. 4:1-11, 4:23-25; Mark 5:1-20; 2 Cor. 4:4, 12:7
- Burdened by the **religious**. Luke 13:14-17; Matt. 12:7-8; Luke 14:1-6; John 5:9-10, 16; Deut. 4:2; Matt. 5:18; Rev. 22:18; Mark 2:23-28

Finding hope in a hopeless life. Luke 13:11-13, 16

- Jesus **sees** your hopelessness and brings hope. Luke 13:11-12; Ps. 139:7-12; John 4:16-18, 8:1-11, 5:1-6, 9:1-3; Luke 15:11-32; Matt. 8:1-3
- Jesus **calls** you in your hopelessness and brings hope. Luke 13:11-12, 5:1-11; John 5:6; Matt. 8:23-24, 11:28-30; Heb. 4:15-16
- Jesus brings **healing** and deliverance to the hopeless. Luke 13:11-13, 16; Mark 5:1-43; John 5:1-9; Mark 3:1-20; Matt. 8:17, 8:18, 5:41-42; John 8:1-6; Mark 5:23; Luke 4:18-23

Application.

- Accept the **hope** that Christ offers.
- Glorify **Him** in the hope you find.

Five categories of miracles.

1. "**Nature's** miracles." John 2; Luke 5; John 21; Matt. 14:22-23
2. "Miracle of **bodily** healing." John 5:1-15, 9:1-3, 11:43-45; Mark 5:1-43
3. "Healing those possessed with **demons**." Matt. 8:28-34; Mark 1:21-28, 5:1-20
4. "The miracle of **multiplication**." John 6:1-14
5. "The **power** to raise the dead." Luke 7:11-17; Matt. 8:19-26; John 11:40-45
