15. Lord, let the students and faculty of this school be protected from physical harm. Put a shield of protection around them the way You put a shield of protection around Job. (Psalm 91:1; Job 1:10)
16. Lord, do not allow any child to be bullied but deliver them from the hand of those who would want to hurt or discourage them. (Psalm 18:16-19)

17. God, don't let any unwholesome talk come out of the mouths, or hearts of these students, but only what is helpful for building others up, that it may benefit those who listen, whether it be through verbal communication or social media communication. (Ephesians 4:29)
18. God, may Your favor rest on the students and faculty of this school. Establish the work of their hands. Let them look to You for help and guidance. (Psalm 90:17)
