- It does not mean being <u>sealed</u> or secured by the Spirit. Eph. 1:13, 4:30; 2 Cor. 1:22
- It does not mean being <u>baptized</u> in the Spirit. 1 Cor. 12:13;
 Rom. 8:9; Matt. 3:11; Eph. 4:4-5

What does it mean? Eph. 5:18

- Command. Eph. 5:18; John 14:15, 21-23; Luke 9:23; Col. 3:17
- Call to <u>obedience</u>. Eph. 5:18; Phil. 2:13; Rom. 6:13-16; John 14:15, 21-23; John 4:34, 5:30, 6:38
- <u>Control</u>. Eph. 5:18; 2 Pet. 1:21; Luke 5:36, 6:11; Acts 6:5, 5:3
- <u>Continuous</u>. Eph. 5:18; Luke 9:23; John 3:30
- <u>Confession</u>. 1 John 1:9; Ps. 66:18; Prov. 28:13

What are the results? Eph. 5:18-21

- Empowers us to live <u>daily</u> for Him. Eph. 5:18; Phil. 4:13; Gal. 2:20; 1 John 4:4
- Empowers us from <u>within</u>. Eph. 5:18-19; John 15:10; Phil. 4:5-8; Rom. 12:1-2, 8:29
- Empowers us **outwardly**. Eph. 5:21-6:5
- Empowers us to <u>look</u> upward. Eph. 5:20; 2 Cor. 9:15
