Jesus calls for Peter. John 21:4-11

- In spite of his failures Jesus <u>sends</u> for Peter. Mark 16:7; John 13:8; 18:10; Luke 22:61; Jon. 1:23; 3:1-3
- In spite of his failures Jesus <u>met</u> with Peter. Luke 24:34; 1 Cor. 15:4-5;
 Rom. 3:23; 6:23
- In spite of his failures Jesus would <u>challenge</u> Peter (obedience). John 21:4-11; Luke 5:4-11; Mark 1:17-18; John 14; 15:21-23; 15:10; Col. 1:23

Jesus restores Peter. John 21:15-17

- Confronted with <u>sin</u> and renouncing of self-sufficiency. John 21:15-17;
 Ps. 51:4; John 15:5; Phil. 4:13; James 4:8-10; 1 Pet. 5:6
- Confronted to <u>move</u> from the point of his supremacy to the love of Jesus Christ. John 21:15-17; 1 Cor. 13:4-8; Matt. 18:5-10; 1 Pet. 5:1-3; Acts 20:28; 2 Cor. 12:9-10; Acts 2:14-40; 3:12-26

Jesus reenlisted Peter. John 21:18-19

- Peter would <u>never</u> be the same. 2 Cor. 5:17; Gal. 2:20;Rom. 12:1-2; Acts 2:14-40; 3:12-26
- Peter would <u>pay</u> the ultimate price of martyrdom. John 21:18-19;
 Matt. 10:38-39; Rom. 14:8; Phil. 1:21; 1 Pet. 4:14-16
