Know God

Yes, God is the only one who can get us through this time! It is because of His love for us that we know He is always with us and will take care of us! His love gives us hope! We see that very deep love in John 3:16 *"For God so loved the world that He gave His only Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish, but shall have eternal life".* This verse touches us with a deeper passion this year as we look at this Easter Season with a new perspective due to our circumstances. 1John 4 goes a step further, "This is love: not that we loved God, but that He loved us and sent His Son as an atoning sacrifice for our sins."

How well do you know your Lord? Author Nick Harrison shares that people, as they pray, see what used to be confusing or unknowable about God becomes a secret knowledge between them and their God. What a precious gift that is from the Lord! God has purpose for us in this time. Use it to know Him better and you will find a stronger relationship with Him and a revived spirit for this Holy Week and Easter Resurrection Sunday.

Start your time with the Lord with a praise psalm or your favorite praise song. Yes, He is the Miracle Worker! The One we sing about on Sunday! Listen and sing along with Pastor Carey and the Worship Team <u>HERE</u>.

- Praise You, Lord, for You are the Way Maker! Lord, I know You will make a way for me and my family where there seems to be no way!
 "See, I am doing a new thing! Now it springs up; do you not perceive it? I am making a way in the wilderness and streams in the wasteland." (Is 43:19)
- Lord, we thank you for bringing us through difficult times in the past and thank you in advance for being here now to do what only You are able to do to help us. "For nothing will be impossible with God." (Luke 1:37)
- We praise You, Lord, for You are the Alpha and Omega (beginning & end), omniscient, omnipotent and omnipresent (all knowing, all powerful and always everywhere)."
 "I am the Alpha and the Omega—the beginning and the end," says the Lord God. "I am the One who is, who always was, and who is still to come—the Almighty One." (Rev 1:8)
 "Even before there is a word on my tongue, Behold, O Lord, You know it all." (Ps 139:4)
 "By the word of the Lord the heavens were made, their starry host by the breath of His mouth." (Ps 33:6)

"Do I not fill heaven and earth?' declares the Lord" (Jer 23:24)

• You are the Miracle Worker, Lord! Provide the researchers with insights to develop the treatments and vaccines needed to eradicate this virus.

"You are the God who performs miracles; You display Your power among the peoples." (Ps 77:14)

- Lord, give us a new passion for loving one another and reaching out to share the gospel. Let that passion intensify with each day.
 "Beloved, let us love one another, for love is from God, and whoever loves has been born of God and knows God. Anyone who does not love does not know God, because God is Love. (1John 4:7-8)
- Lord, You are the Promise Keeper! We praise You for Your Word gives us 3,000+ promises and You tell us You keep Your promises!
 "... not one of all the good promises the Lord Your God gave you has failed. Every promise has been fulfilled; not one has failed." (Josh 23:14)
- Lord, help me to know You better so I will recognize Your voice and take the time to listen to You; so I will serve you by being in the center of Your will.
 "Now this is the confidence that we have in Him, that if we ask anything according to His will, He hears us." (1John 5:124)
- Lord, You are the Light in the Darkness! Though we see darkness in these days, we also see how You are working to give us encouragement, endurance, and drawing us to a deeper relationship with You.

"In Him (Jesus) was life, and that life was the light of all mankind. The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness has not overcome it." (John 1:4-5)
