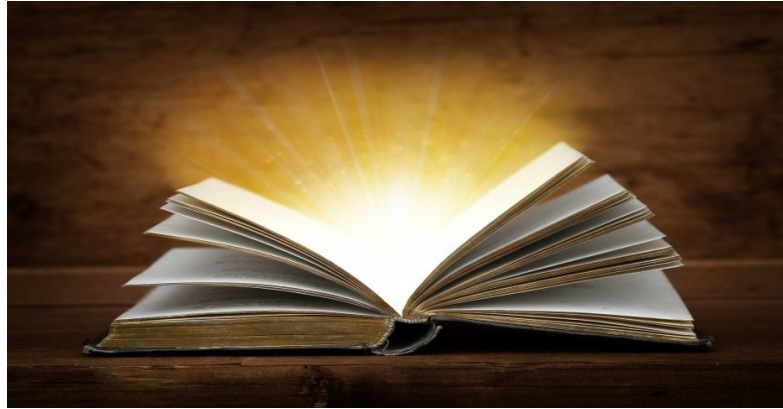


Pray God's Word

Addiction

- ◆ "Now faith is confidence in what we hope for and assurance about what we do not see." (Heb 11:11)

Confusion

"For God is not the author of confusion but of peace, as in all the churches of the saints." (1Cor 14:33 NASB)

Courage

"Wait on the LORD; be of good courage, And He shall strengthen your heart; wait, I say on the Lord." (Ps 27:14 NKJV)

Depression

"When you pass through the waters, I will be with you; and when you pass through the rivers, they will not sweep over you. When you walk through the fire, you will not be burned; the flames will not set you ablaze." (Is 43:2)

Discernment

"And I pray this: that your love will keep on growing in knowledge and every kind of discernment, . . ." (Phil 1:9 HCSB)

Doubt

*"Truly I tell you, if anyone says to this mountain, 'Go, throw yourself into the sea,' and does not **doubt** in their heart but believes that what they say will happen, it will be done for them." (Mark 11:23)*

Encouragement

"Have I not commanded you? Be strong and courageous. Do not be afraid: do not be discouraged, for the Lord your God will be with you wherever you go" (Jos 1:9).

Faith

"Now faith is the assurance of things hoped for, the conviction of things not seen." (Heb 11:1, NASB)

Fear

"For God has not given us a spirit of fear, but of power and of love and of a sound mind." (2Tim 1:7)

Forgiveness

- ◆ "If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness." (1John 1:9)
- ◆ "Do not judge, and you will not be judged. Do not condemn, and you will not be condemned. Forgive, and you will be forgiven." (Luke 6:37)

God's Love

"For God so loved the world that He gave His one and only Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish but have eternal life." (John 3:16)

God's Guidance

- ◆ "Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding; in all your ways submit to Him, and He will make your paths straight." (Prov 3:5-6)
- ◆ "Be strong and very courageous. Be careful to obey all the law (Ten Commandments) my servant Moses gave you; do not turn from it to the right or to the left, that you may be successful." (Joshua 1:7)

Grief

"In the same way, the Spirit helps us in our weakness. We do not know what we ought to pray for, but the Spirit Himself intercedes for us through wordless groans." (Rom 8:26)

Grace

"For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith—and this is not from yourselves, it is the gift of God—." (Eph 2:8)

Pray God's Words



Healing

- ◆ “Lord my God, I called to you for help, and You healed me.” (Ps 30:2)
- ◆ “Praise the LORD, my soul, and forget not all his benefits— who forgives all your sins and heals all your diseases.” (Ps 103:2-3)

Hope

- ◆ “but those who hope in the Lord will renew their strength. They will soar on wings like eagles; they will run and not grow weary, they will walk and not be faint.” (Is 40:31)
- ◆ “Praise be to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ! In His great mercy He has given us new birth into a living **hope** through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead,” (1Peter 1:3)

Interceding for you

- ◆ “And He (God) who searches our hearts knows the mind of the Spirit, because the Spirit intercedes for God’s people in accordance with the will of God.” (Rom 8:27)
- ◆ “. . . Christ Jesus is the One who died, but even more, has been raised; He also is at the right hand of God and intercedes for us.” (Rom 8:34)

Loneliness

“The Lord Himself goes before you and will be with you, He will never leave you nor forsake you. Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged.” (Deut 31:8)

Love

“A new command I give you: Love one another. As I have loved you, so you must love one another.” (John 13:34)

Money/Finances

- ◆ “But seek first His kingdom and His righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well.” (Matt 6:33)
- ◆ “A tithe (10%) of everything from the land, whether grain from the soil or fruit from the trees, belongs to the Lord; it is holy to the Lord.” (Lev 27:30)

“But Peter and the apostles replied, “We must obey God rather than men.” (Acts 5:29 HCSB)

Our needs

“And my God shall supply all your need according to His riches in glory by Christ Jesus.” (Phil 4:19)

Peace

“You will keep him in perfect peace, whose mind is stayed on You, because he trusts in You.” (Is 26:3 HCSB)

Pride

“Pride comes before destruction, and an arrogant spirit before a fall.” (Prov 16:18)

Protection

- ◆ “for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, and all are justified freely by His grace through the redemption that came by Christ Jesus.” (Rom 3:23-24)
- ◆ “As far as the east is from the west, so far does he remove our sins from us.” (Ps 103:12)

Salvation

“If you declare with your mouth, ‘Jesus is Lord,’ and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved.” (Rom 10:9)

Strength

“He gives strength to the weary and increases the power of the weak.” (Is 40:29)

Temptation

- ◆ “Submit yourselves, then, to God. Resist the devil and he will flee from you.” (James 4:7)
- ◆ “Watch and pray so that you will not fall into temptation. The spirit is willing, but the flesh is weak.” (Matt 26:41)

Troubling Times

- ◆ “Though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil for Your rod and Your staff are with me” (Ps 23:4).
- ◆ “and call on Me in the day of trouble; I will deliver you, and you will honor me.” (Ps 50:15)

Trust

“The Lord is my strength and my shield; my heart trusts in Him, and He helps me.” (Ps 28:7)

Wisdom/Guidance

- ◆ “If any of you lacks wisdom, you should ask God, who gives generously to all without finding fault, and it will be given to you.” (James 1:5)
- ◆ “Your word is a lamp for my feet, a light on my path.” (Ps 119:10)

Worry

“And over all these virtues put on love, which binds them all together perfect unity. Let the peace of Christ rule in your hearts, since as members of one body you were called to peace. And be thankful.” (Col 3:14-15)
