Please continue that provision regardless of the situations that may occur in our community. (Matt 6:31-32)

Father, there is so much going on around us with the Covid situation and the ripple effect in the lives of the students and teachers. We ask you to clear their minds, remove all the distractions and confusion so the focus can be on learning for the students and for the teachers, what needs to be taught and how they will teach it. (Is 26:3; Phil 4:6-7)

Lord, help the students and teachers look to the future, thinking about the things that are true, honest, just, pure, lovely, good and virtuous. Help them do their work as unto You, leaning on You to give them the strength to do all they have to do. Help them remember their help is in You. (Phil 3:13, 4:8, 13; Col 3:23; Ps 121:2)

God, you are the God of Peace. Let our teachers and students look to You for peace and hope. Give them Your peace that passes understanding to guard their hearts and minds in Christ Jesus.
