What is Abomination of Desolation?

Matt. 24:15; Rev. 17:45, 21:27

Abomination: Denotes an object of disgust, repulsion and is used primarily to denote things associated with idolatry and gross ungodliness. It was often used of rites and paraphernalia associated with the wicked conduct of pagan religions.

Abomination of Desolation: The abomination which makes desolate or lays waste.
