Prophets, prophecy. Rom. 12:6; 1 Cor. 12:10, 28; Eph. 4:17

- Characteristics.
 - Prophecy is the ability to communicate God's Word with power, conviction and clarity, and to <u>apply</u> it to the specific situation of the hearers.
 - To speak <u>faith</u> and to do so publicly.
 - Prophets are <u>very</u> opinionated, individualistic and driven by a sense of urgency.
- · Function within the body of Christ.
 - To edify, exhort and console the <u>body</u> of Christ. 1 Cor. 14:3
 - To instruct, admonish, <u>warn</u>, rebuke, correct, challenge, comfort and encourage believers. 2 Cor. 1:3-4; 2 Tim. 3:16-17; Gal. 5:16, 22-23; Gal. 2:20; Phil. 4:3; 1 Cor. 10:13
 - o Proclaim and preach the Word. 2 Tim. 4:2, 2:15

Service and gift of helps. Rom. 12:7; 1 Cor. 12:28; Acts 6:1-3

- Characteristics.
 - Service is the unique capacity to recognize practical <u>needs</u> and to meet them joyfully and efficiently, thereby freeing other Christians to perform their ministries.
 - Gift of helps. To take the burden <u>off</u> someone else and place it on yourself.
 - Likes to <u>meet</u> needs immediately.
 - Has a hard time saying <u>no</u>.
