Why? James 5:13-15

- We **all** have suffering and sickness in our lives. James 5:13-15; 1:2; 1 Pet. 4:12; 5:7; Phil. 4:6; Col. 4:2; 2 Cor. 1:3-4; 11:21, 29; 12:10; 1 Chr. 16:11; 1 Thess. 5:14
- We all have **sinned**. James 5:15; Rom. 3:23; 6:23; Ps. 32:3-5; Prov. 28:13; 1 John 1:9

Who? James 5:13-16

- We can **pray** for ourselves. James 5:13; Jonah 2:7; 1 Pet. 5:6-7; Matt. 7:7; Eph. 6:10-20; Phil. 4:6-7; Matt. 6:9-15
- We can call for the **elders** to pray for us. James 5:14-16; Acts 6:4; Gal. 6:1; 5:22-23; 1 John 2:13-15; Matt. 6:17; Luke 7:46; John 11:2; 12:3; Mark 6:13; John 14:13-14
- We can call the **body** of Christ to pray for us. James 5:13-16; 1 Pet. 2:24; John 15:7; James 5:18; 1 Cor. 12:1-31; Rom. 12:10-21

What? James 5:13-16

- We can be **restored** to spiritual wholeness. James 5:15; Gal. 6:1
- We can receive **help** from others with the hardships of life. 2 Cor. 1:3-11
- We can pray for others, because **others** have prayed for us. 2 Cor. 1:3-11; Eph. 1:15-23
