Why He should be preeminent. Col. 1:13-17

- He <u>delivers</u> us from darkness and redeems us for forgiveness.

- He makes <u>God</u> visible. Col. 1:15; John 14:9; 2 Cor. 4:4; John 1:18;
 1 John 4:9; Heb. 1:3
- He is the <u>creator</u> of all things. Col. 1:15-17; Eph. 1:20-21;
 Phil. 2:9-17; John 1:1-3; Matt. 14:32-33; 8:1-26; Mark 1:26;
 5:35-43; John 11:43

Why He is not preeminent.

- We make ourselves <u>first</u>, not Him. Luke 9:59-61; Matt. 19:16-27
- We sometimes place others in <u>His</u> place. Luke 9:59-61
- We sometimes place our ambition, <u>pleasure</u> or possessions first.
 Matt. 6:21, 24; 19:21-22; 2 Tim. 4:10; 1 John 2:15-17

How to place Him as preeminent.

- We <u>love</u> Him more than life itself. Joshua 24:15; Matt. 6:33; 6:21,
 24
- We <u>obey</u> Him first and foremost. Matt. 6:33; 6:21, 24; 2 Cor. 5:14; John 14:15, 21, 23; 15:10
- We are willing to <u>submit</u> to His will. Matt. 26:36-46; John 17:4;
 4:34; 5:30; 6:38
