- Jesus Christ <u>predicted</u> His death and resurrection. Matt. 16:21; 12:40; 17:9; 20:19

Who do you say that Jesus is? Matt. 16:15-17, 21-24

- It determines our <u>destiny</u> (salvation). Matt. 16:15-16; John 6:51; 10:9; 14:6; Acts 4:12; 8:36-37; Luke 18:9-14
- It determines who is in <u>charge</u> of our lives (surrender). Matt. 16:16, 21-24; Luke 9:57-62; Rom. 6:13-16; Matt. 6:33; 1 John 2:15-17; Matt. 26:36-46
- It determines how we <u>live</u> our lives daily (sanctification).
