What can happen when God opens my eyes?

- The Word of God enables me to see <u>solutions</u> to my problems. Gen. 21:14-18; 21:19; Matt. 18:15-17; Eph. 4:32; Gal. 6:1-2
- The Word of God enables me to see the **barriers** to my progress. Num. 22:22-27, 31; Is. 55:8-9; Acts 16:16; 18:19
- The Word of God enables me to see the <u>defense</u> for what is attacking me. 2 Kin. 6:10-23; 6:15-17; Rom. 8:31; 2 Chr. 32:7-8; Ex. 14:13; James 1:5; Prov. 3:5-6
- The Word of God enables me to see how God <u>walks</u> with me. Luke 24:15-29; 24:31; Acts 12:1-12; 16:22-40; Luke 8:40-42, 49-56; 2 Chr. 32:7-8; 2 Tim. 4:16-18

How do I prepare to see what God wants me to see?

- I <u>start</u> off with a relationship with Jesus. 1 Cor. 2:14; 2 Cor. 4:4; John 3:3
- I move to asking God in faith to <u>open</u> my eyes. Ps. 119:18;
 James 1:5-6; Ps. 32:8; Matt. 7:7
- I must come with a <u>humble</u> attitude. Ps. 25:9; Prov. 3:5-6;
 James 4:6; 1 Pet. 5:6
- I must cleanse my <u>heart</u> of sin and conflict. Matt. 5:8; 1 John 2:11;
 Matt. 5:23-24; 1 John 1:9; Matt. 18:15
- I must be willing to **commit** in advance to what God says. Ps. 119:33-34; James 1:22
