- Do you <u>hear</u> me LORD? Hab. 1:1-2; Ps. 10:1; 13:1-2; 22:1-2; 47:3; 2 Cor. 12:1-10; Matt. 26:36-46
- Do you <u>know</u> what's going on? Heb. 1:3-4; Is. 55:8-9; 2 Cor. 12:1-10; Jer. 20:18, 8; Ps. 73:2-3; 139:1-6
- Do you really <u>mean</u> what you say? Hab. 1:5-11; Job 2-3, 38-40; 42:1-6; Matt. 36:31-35

What can we learn from all of this? Is. 55:8-9

- We can only <u>see</u> what we can see. Is. 55:8-9; Matt. 24:36; Mark 13:32; Rev. 1:8; 21:16
- We cannot <u>limit</u> God to our way of thinking. Is. 55:8-9; Job. 2-3; 38-40; Ps. 115:3; 135:6
- We need to realize God is <u>bigger</u> than we think. Hab. 1:2, 5-11; Ex. 5-14; Josh. 6:1-21; 10:13; 1 Cor. 15:3-8
