Walking on water. Matt. 14:27-33

- Courage to get <u>out</u> of the boat. Mark 14:27-29; Acts 2:14-47;
 4:5-25; 5:17-39; 9:6-31
- Desire and obedience to <u>walk</u> on water. Matt. 14:28-29;
 Acts 4:5-25; 5:17-39; Phil. 1:21; John 3:30
- Depending upon <u>ourselves</u> is risky. Matt. 14:29-30; Luke 18:9-27; Matt. 16:21-24; 26:31-35
- Dependence upon <u>Christ</u> is not risky but right. Matt. 14:29-31;
 Is. 43:18-19; 2 Cor. 5:7, 12, 1-10; Gal. 5:16, 24; Rom. 13:14; 8:4;
 Phil. 1:21
