Why did Peter fall? Matt. 26:69-75

- He didn't <u>listen</u> to God's Word. Matt. 26:31-33; Luke 22:31; John 13:37; Mark 14:31; Gen. 2:16-17; 3:1-7; 1 Cor. 10:1-12
- He was in the <u>wrong</u> camp. Matt. 26:69; Luke 22:55; John 18:25; 18:6; 2 Pet. 2:9; 1 Cor. 10:13
- He followed after <u>Christ</u> at a distance. Matt. 26:58; Luke 22:54; Gen. 3:8; Ps. 119:11; Heb. 10:24-25
- He was unprepared for <u>what</u> was going to happen. Matt. 26:40-41, 45; Luke 22:40, 45-46
- He compounded his <u>sin</u> first by deceiving, then denying and finally swearing. Matt. 26:69-72; John 18:25; 1 Sam. 15:1-20; Gen. 20:1-18

Peter returning to the Lord. Matt. 26:74-75

- It started when he <u>heard</u> the rooster crow. Matt. 26:74-75; Luke 22:61; Matt. 26:34; Luke 22:31-32
- He moved to the <u>look</u> of Jesus Christ. Luke 22:60-61; 22:32-33, 54-59; Matt. 28:19-20; John 15:5; Acts 1:8
- He contended with the <u>words</u> of Jesus. Matt. 26:75; 34; Luke 22:61; Mark 14:30, 72; Ps. 119:11; Luke 23:42; Ex. 20:1-17; Eccl. 12:1
- Finally he <u>wept</u> bitterly. Matt. 26:75; Luke 22:32; 2 Cor. 7:10; 1 John 1:9; Prov. 28:13; Ps. 51:4, 17
