- Spiritual battle is <u>relentless</u>. Eph. 6:11, 14; 2 Cor. 10:5; Matt. 4:1-10; 1 Pet. 5:8
- Spiritual battle—Satan is a <u>defeated</u> foe. Eph. 6:11, 14;
 Rom. 8:31-38; 1 Cor. 15:55-57

Spiritual victory (weapons of warfare). Eph. 6:17

- The Bible—the word is Logos and refers to the <u>entire</u> word of God's truth. John 1:1; 2 Tim. 2:15
- The Bible—the word is Rhema—the word that speaks to specific <u>needs</u> and situations. Eph. 6:17
- The word Rhema is both <u>defensive</u> and offensive. Eph. 6:17;
 Matt. 4:4, 7, 10; 1 Cor. 10:13; Mark 2:5; Eph. 2:5; John 10:27-30;
 1 Pet. 3:15; Rom. 5:5; Eph. 4:32; Heb. 4:12; 2 Cor. 5:17; Heb. 13:5;
 Phil. 2:2
