- Christ is the **founder** of the church. Matt. 16:13-21
  - Recognize <u>Christ</u> as the founder. Matt. 16:13-17; 1:21-28; John 1:29;
     Cor. 5:21
  - The price Christ <u>paid</u> for the church. Matt. 16:21; 26:54; John 1:29;
     Luke 24:26; Is. 53:1-12
  - The <u>purpose</u> Christ had and has for the church. Matt. 20:28; Acts 4:12; John 3:16-19
- The <u>foundation</u> of the church. 1 Cor. 3:10-11; Matt. 16:18; Acts 4:11-12; Eph. 2:20-22; 1 Pet. 2:4-7

## Why we need the church family.

- Because it <u>proves</u> we are genuine believers. John 13:34-35; 1 Cor. 12:27;
   Gal. 3:28
- Because it <u>moves</u> us away from being self-centered. Gen. 2:18;
   1 Cor. 12:25-27; Eph. 4:16; Rom. 12:4-5; 1 John 3:16
- Because it <u>aids</u> in our spiritual growth and development. Eph. 4:16;
   Heb. 3:13; John 13:34-35; 13:14; Rom. 12:10, 16; 13:8; 14:13; 15:7, 14;
   1 Cor. 12:25; Eph. 4:2, 32; 5:21; Heb. 10:24-25
- Because we share in Christ's mission. Luke 24:46-48; Eph. 2:10

## What are we to do?

- Are you willing to do <u>life</u> with other believers?
- Are you a part of a local church family of believers?
- Are you an attender or member?

The difference between being a church attender and a church member is commitment. Attenders are spectators from the sidelines; members get involved in the ministry. Attenders are consumers; members are contributors. Attenders want the benefits of a church without sharing the responsibility. They are like couples who want to live together without committing to a marriage.

Why is it important to join a local church family? Because it proves you are committed to your spiritual brothers and sisters in reality; not just in theory. God wants you to love real people, not ideal people. You can spend a lifetime searching for the perfect church, but you will never find it. You are called to love imperfect sinners, just as God does.
