- God providing man's redemption.
 - o Jesus (Savior). He is the deliverer—being <u>saved</u> from terrible disaster that leads to perishing. Matt. 1:18-21; Luke 2:11; John 3:16; Rom. 8:3
 - Christ. The Anointed <u>One</u>. Matt. 1:18; Luke 2:11; Deut. 18:15-19; Ps. 110:4;
 2 Sam. 7:12-13
 - LORD—possessing authority, <u>power</u> and control. Luke 1:32; 2:11; Col. 1:15, 18; Rev. 3:4; 17:4
 - o Immanuel (God with <u>us</u>). Matt. 1:23; Is. 7:14; 8:8, 10; Gal. 4:4; Phil. 2:7-11
 - o **Son** of God and Deity of Jesus Christ. Luke 1:35; 2 Cor. 5:21; Heb. 4:15; 7:26
- Christ brought joy and peace to us and glory to God. Luke 2:10; Matt. 1:21;

How do angels compare to human beings?

They are stronger than man, but not omnipotent. Psalm 103:20; 2 Peter 2:11

They are greater than man in knowledge, but not omniscient. 2 Samuel 14:20; Matthew 24:36

They are more noble than man, but not omnipresent. Daniel 9:21-23, 10:10-14

Angels can take on the appearance of men when the occasion demands. Hebrews 13:2

Their appearance is sometimes in dazzling white and blazing glory. Matthew 28:2-4

Angels do not marry or reproduce like humans. Matthew 22:30

Angels are a company or association, not a race descended from a common ancestor. Luke 20:34-36

Angels are spirits, like the soul of man, but without a physical body. Hebrews 1:14
