What did he doubt? John 20:24-27

- He doubted the <u>promises</u> of God. John 20:25; Matt. 16:21, 17, 9, 12, 22-23; 20:19; Heb. 13:5; John 1:12; 3:16; Rom. 8:31-39
- He was doubting who <u>Jesus</u> Christ was. John 20:25, 27;
 Matt. 16:13-16; 8:5-13; 4:3; 8:29; Mark 3:11; 14:61;
 Matt. 14:33; Luke 19:38

What Jesus did in response to the doubts. John 20:26-31

- Evidence to the <u>truth</u> of who He was. John 20:26-27; 20:1-8;
 Mark 16:1-8; Matt. 28:1-10; Luke 16:1-8; Acts 1:1-8;
 1 Cor. 15:1-8
- Encouraged and challenged him to <u>believe</u>. John 20:27-29;
 6:1-14; 11:1-45; 2:7-12; Luke 7:1-17
