- It is in the imperative mood. It is a **<u>command</u>** not meant to be optional.
- It is in the **plural**, not singular form. It is for all believers.
- It is in the passive voice. It is not what we do; it is what we <u>allow</u> to be done in us.
- It is in the present tense. It is a repeated <u>action</u>.

- I will <u>surrender</u> to the control of the Holy Spirit in me.
