Redemption. Ex. 3-12

- Redemption is <u>totally</u> of God. Ex. 12:1-5; Eph. 2:8-9; Rom. 5:1, 8; Acts 4:12; John 14:6
- Redemption was through a <u>person</u> (Moses). Ex. 3:16-22; 4:21; 5:1-4; 7:1-7; John 14:6; Matt. 20:28; Luke 19:10
- Redemption by the <u>blood</u>. Ex. 12:1-50; 1 Pet. 1:18-19; Heb. 9:22; 1 Cor. 5:7
- Redemption by the <u>power</u> of God. Ex. 7-14; 11:7; Rom. 3:25-26; Ex. 14:21, 22

Passover lamb. Ex. 12:1-50; 1 Cor. 5:7

- The lamb was to be <u>male</u> and without blemish. Ex. 12:5; 1 Pet. 1:19; 2 Cor. 5:21; 1 Pet. 2:22
- The lamb was to be <u>kept</u> for four days to examine it. Ex. 12:3-6; John 8:46
- The lamb was to be slain. Ex. 12:6; John 12:24; Matt. 16:21
- The lamb's <u>blood</u> was to be applied. Ex. 12:7; John 3:36
- The lamb's blood was applied, and that <u>alone</u> brought salvation. Ex. 12:23; Heb. 10:10, 14; 9:22
- The lamb was not to have a **bone** broken. Ex. 12:46; John 19:33
- We are sheltered by the <u>blood</u>, and we are nourished by the roasted lamb. Ex. 12:13, 23, 27; ls. 31:5; Matt. 26:26
