OUTRAGEOUS FAITH: BY FAITH Hebrews 11:1-2

What faith is not.

- Faith has nothing to do with how we **feel**.
- Faith is not I think so or hope so.
- Faith is not it <u>may</u> be so or it may not be so.
- Faith is not saying it might be **true** or might not be true.

What is faith? Heb. 11:1, 6

- Intellectual assent **believing** something to be true.
- Trust is actually relying on the **facts** that something is true.
- Belief in, <u>devotion</u> to, trust in something or somebody, allegiance or loyalty to somebody or something.
- "Faith means believing in advance what will only make <u>sense</u> in reverse." Phillip Yancey

Several aspects of faith.

- Our faith is believing when we don't <u>see</u> it. Heb. 11:1; 2 Kin. 4:8-37; Matt. 8:5-10; Mark 11:24
- Our faith is willing to **obey** what we don't understand. Gen. 6:13-22; 7:1-5; Heb. 11:8; Matt. 14:28-33
- Our faith is willing to <u>give</u> when we don't have it to give. Mark 12:41-44; Heb. 11:4; 2 Cor. 8:3; 9:6-8;
- Our faith is <u>persistent</u> when we don't feel like it. Gal. 6:9-10; Luke 18:1-8; Heb. 10:37-38; Matt. 5:21-34; 2 Cor. 12:9-10
- Our faith is thanking God <u>before</u> we receive it. John 11:41-46; 2 Chr. 20:18-23
- Our faith is <u>trusting</u> even when we don't get it. Phil. 4:11-13; Heb. 11:39-40; Matt. 26:36-46; 2 Cor. 12:7-10
