WHAT ARE WE TO DO WHEN GOD SAYS, "NO"? Jeremiah 33:3

God saying, "No".

- Biblical <u>characters</u> that God said no to. 1 Kin. 19:1-4; Num. 13-14; 1 Chr. 17:4; 2 Sam. 7:1-29; 1 Chr. 22:7-8; Matt. 26:36-46; 2 Cor. 12:1-10
- When God says no to you it may not be for the <u>same</u> reason He says no to others. Job 2:11-13; 16:2; 42:7-9; 4-25

Several reasons God says, "No".

- God will say no because he has a much <u>bigger</u> perspective.
 Heb. 4:13; 2 Chr. 16:9; Ps. 33:13-15; Job 26:6; Prov. 2:8; Dan. 3, 6
- God will say no when He has a <u>better</u> plan. Is. 55:8-9; Heb. 11:38-39;
 1 Kin. 19:1-4; Is. 46:10; Eccl. 8:7; 10:14; Acts 8:25-40; 16:6
- God will say no because He has a <u>greater</u> purpose. Ps. 57:2;
 2 Cor. 4:17-18; 1 Pet. 1:7
 - There are some things that we will not <u>understand</u> until we get to heaven. Eccl. 11:5; Deut. 29:29; 1 Cor. 2:7; Col. 2:2-3; Eph. 1:9; 3:4-5
 - Some things will happen in our lives which <u>never</u> change until we get to heaven. 2 Cor. 12:1-10; 1 Pet. 5:6-8; Jer. 29:11; Is. 55:8-9; 2 Cor. 1:3-8
 - Sometimes we will suffer for the <u>benefit</u> of other people.
 2 Cor. 1:3-8; 12:1-10; Matt. 6:47; 27:58

What are we to do when God says, "No"?

- Realize that everything God does is in His goodness and <u>love</u>—trust Him. John 3:16; Ps. 25:10; Rom. 8:28; Ps. 136:26; 107:1; 31:19; Rom. 5:2-5, 8
- When we are in pain, pray like Jesus prayed facing the <u>cross</u>. Matt. 26:36, 42
 - Pray in pain affirming <u>God's</u> power. Matt. 26:36,42; 19:23-26; Luke 1:37; Rom. 8:31
 - Pray in pain—we <u>ask</u> with passion. Matt. 26:37-39; Luke 22:44;
 Cor. 12:1-10; John 11:33
 - Pray in pain—we <u>accept</u> God's plan. Matt. 26:39, 42; Is. 55:8-9;
 James 1:5
 - Pray expecting God to give His grace to <u>handle</u> His answer.
 2 Cor. 12:8-10; James 1:2; 1 Pet. 1:6; 4:12-16; Is. 41:10; Phil. 4:19; Ps. 147:3; 2 Cor. 1:3-8
