- The test of a <u>true</u> prophet of God is they are always right.

- Past. Dan. 1:5-10; 2 Cor. 11:24-33; 1 Sam. 18:10-11; 19:10; 20:33
- **Present**. Dan. 2:1-13; 2 Cor. 4:8-12; Matt. 26:36-46
- Future. Dan. 6:1-28

What is our response to the impossible? Dan. 2:1-49

- Negative response. 1 Kin. 19:3
 - Panic and <u>fear</u>. Dan. 2:10-11; Matt. 26:56, 69-75; 1 Sam. 18:10-11; 19:10; 20:33
 - Anxiety and worry. Dan. 2:4-11
 - Depression and <u>despair</u>. Dan. 2:4-11
- Positive response. Dan. 2:14-47
 - Take <u>time</u> for wisdom and discernment. Dan. 2:14-16; Eph. 5:16; James 1:5-7
 - Seek God in <u>prayer</u> and ask others to pray. Dan. 2:17-18; Jer. 33:3; Dan. 6:10: Phil. 4:6
 - Praise and worship God when He answers us. Dan. 2:19-23
 - Serve <u>others</u>. Dan. 2:24-26
 - Direct others to <u>God</u>. Dan. 2:24-30, 46-49; Matt. 28:19-20; Acts 1:8; Rom. 10:15
