**God's love for us. John 3:16; Rom. 5:8; 1 John 4:9-10**

- God's love is **personal**. John 3:16; Rom. 5:8
  - He **knows** my name. Luke 19:5; John 10:14, 27; 1 Sam. 3:1-10; Jer. 1:5; Is. 43:1; 49:16
  - He **seeks** and searches for me. 1 John 4:9-10; Rom. 5:8; John 3:16; 6:44; 12:32
- God's love came at a **radical** price. 1 John 4:9-10; John 3:16
  - The radical price was His **son**. John 3:16; 1 John 4:9-10; 5:11
  - The radical price was His son giving His **life**. 1 John 4:9-10; 3:16; John 10:11; 15:13; 1 John 2:1-2; Rom. 5:8; 8:34; 2 Cor. 5:21; 1 Pet. 2:24

**Our love for God.**

- My love for God is seen in my **trusting** in God. Prov. 3:5-7; Jer. 17:7-8; Prov. 28:25-26; 29:25; John 3, 4, 8, 11
- My love for God is seen in my **obedience** to God. 1 John 4:7-8; 3:16; 2:3-6; John 14:15, 21, 23; 15:10; Luke 9:23
- My love for God is seen in my **transformation**. Rom. 12:1-2; 8:29; 1 Cor. 2:1-5; 1 Thess. 4:3; 2 Pet. 3:18; 1 Cor. 6:19-20; 3:16; Eph. 4:13-16

**Loving one another. 1 John 4:7-16; John 13:34-35**

- A sacrificial love that is willing to **sacrifice** first. 1 John 4:9-10; 3:16-17; John 15:13; 10:11; 17-18
- A giving love that willingly gives **before** it receives. John 13:30-34; 2 Cor. 8:1-5; 1 Cor. 13:4-8; Col. 3:12-13; Phil. 2:2-8
- A serving love that steps up to be the first to **serve**. John 13:34; Matt. 20:28; John 13:12-17; 1 Pet. 4:11; Heb. 6:10; Gal. 5:13; Rom. 12:11
- An unconditional love which loves **first** and without regrets. John 13:34; 1 Cor. 13:1-8; Matt. 26:47-49; Rom. 5:8; John 3:16; 1 John 4:10, 19
