- To live one's life without problems, **troubles**, and loss.

Purpose restored. Rom. 8:28-30

- He calls us to a <u>relationship</u> with Him. Rom. 8:28-30; John 1:12; Rev. 3:20; John 3:16; 2 Pet. 3:9; John 12:33; 6:44
- He seeks to <u>conform</u> us into His image. Rom. 8:29; 12:1-2;
 Gen. 1:26-27; 2 Cor. 5:17; 2 Pet. 1:4; Gal. 2:20; 2 Cor. 3:18
- He calls us to <u>live</u> with Him forever. Rom. 8:30; 1 John 3:2;
 Rom. 8:18; Eph. 1:18; Col. 3:4

Purpose (conforming). Rom. 8:28-29

- God uses <u>events</u> and circumstances to conform us. Rom. 8:28-29; Gen. 22:1-20; 50:20; Matt. 26:67-75; Acts 2-8; 2 Cor. 12:9-10; Rom. 5:4-5
- By our <u>obedience</u> we will be conformed (spiritual maturity).

 - Spiritual maturity comes in <u>living</u> by the Word of God. Josh. 1:7-8; Matt. 4:4; Ps. 119:1-3, 11, 97-105; 2 Tim. 2:15; 3:15
 - Spiritual maturity comes in <u>communication</u> with God.
