- 3. Why do you think the message of Jesus Christ spread quickly?

- 5. What's happened in your life that caused you to view God in a brand-new way?

#### For ADULTS:

- 1. Compare the Peter we read about in the Gospels to the Peter we read about in the opening chapters of Acts. What are the chief similarities? What are the chief differences?
- 2. The early church struggled to unite very different peoples. What steps did it take for them to become a united body? What can we learn from their example?
