These situations apply not only to us personally but to our nation, and also to much of the world.

We have a window of time which we may never have again! Most of us don't want to look at the negative while the markets are up but this gives us a false sense of security to what is really happening in our nation. From "The Return's" resources, here are just a few vital statistics and cultural indications showing us how America has been changing and why we need to return to the Lord. Please lift up prayers concerning these facts as you read through them:

- **U.S. National Debt:** In 1980 it was less than \$1 Trillion, now almost \$25 Trillion. We are stealing from our children & grandchildren at the rate of \$100+ million an hour, but most Americans don't seem to care we are rapidly bankrupting our nation.
- Unmarried Mothers: In 1956, about 5% of all babies born in the U.S. were born to unmarried mothers. 2008 was the first year in history that 40% we born to unmarried mothers and that level has continued to stay the same for 8 years.
- **Middle Class:** In early 1970, 60+% of all Americans were considered in the Middle Class, but in 2015 that number dipped below 50% for the first time ever.
- Affording Homes: In 2001 nearly 16 million Americans could not afford the homes they were living in, but by 2015 that number more than doubled.
- **Public Education:** A study of Millennials in 22 major industrialized nations conducted by Educational Testing Service found that only 2 countries were worse when it comes to literacy proficiency, and we were dead last when it comes to math.
- Young Married Men: In the early 1970's 70% of men in the U.S. (ages 20-39) were married. Today the percent has fallen to 35%. And now, 35% of all young men (age 21-30) are still living at home with parents or a close relative.
- **Drugs:** The U.S. has the highest rate of illegal drug use in the entire planet. And concerning legal drugs, a Mayo Clinic study shows nearly 70% of all Americans are on at least one prescription drug & 20% of all Americans are on at least 5 prescription drugs.
- Sexually Transmitted Diseases: According to the CDC, 110 million Americans currently have sexually transmitted diseases out of the total U.S. population of 308 million, and there are about 20 million new STD cases in the U.S. every year.
