

Prayer-walking – What to pray for

- Pray for teachers and students who are unbelievers, that they might come to know the Lord.
- Pray that the students will know the love of the Father and assurance of His great love.
 - *“How great is the love of the Father has lavished on us, that we should be called Children of God” 1 John 3:1*
- Pray that the students will be prevented from obtaining weapons.
- Pray for the protection from alcohol, sexual activity, and violence.
 - *“Holy Father, protect them by the power of your name.” John 17:11*
- Pray for protection from hate, envy, jealousy, greed, and selfishness.
- Pray for Christian student to keep their bodies pure because they are the temple of the Holy Spirit.
 - *“your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit...therefore honor God with your body” 1 Corinthians 6:19-20.*
- Pray for the parents of the children who attend these schools.
- Pray for their homes, that God will remove violence and replace it with His love and that the Holy Spirit will dwell there.
- Pray for the teachers to experience God’s leadership as they teach and discipline. Pray that God will protect them.
- Pray that the student will have respect for *authorities*.
 - *“Everyone must submit himself to the governing authorities, for there is no authority except that which God has established.” Romans 13:1.*
- Pray for protection on the playgrounds, as young people gather there.
- Pray for the school bus drivers and their riders.
- Pray for Christian students to withstand peer-pressure by knowing who they are in Christ, what they have in Christ, and what they can do through first.
 - *“For we are God’s workmanship, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God has prepared in advance for us to do.” Ephesians 2:10.*
- Pray for Christian students, that they would follow God fully, support one another in Christ, and be witnesses to their non-Christian classmates and teachers.
 - *“May they be brought to complete unity to let the world know that you [God] sent me [Jesus] and have loved them even as you have loved me.” John 17:23*
